- 1. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 AM by Chair Vickie Williams in the Main Street Conference Room B at 22 E Main St Edmond, OK.**
- 2. Introduction of Members and Guests.** Chair Vickie Williams welcomed everyone. All present introduced themselves.
- 3. Approval of the Minutes of December 12, 2025, meeting.** Lissa Wohltmann made the motion. Kurt Sampley seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows:

- 4. Presentation and Discussion of Engineering Project Updates – Brad Moery, Engineering Department.** Brad gave an update on trail projects. Vickie asked that in the future Engineering shows where the funds came from for the projects (what grants) and \$\$ amounts. Lissa asked if a crossing of Midwest Blvd on 2nd St is involved with the NW Connector Trail and Brad said no but could be considered since the speed of vehicles on 2nd St is so high. Brad said the width and design of the Spring Creek to Carl Rehman Trail will match the Spring Creek Trail. Brad said ODOT just finished its 60% review of the Post to Westminster Trail and estimates construction starting in the fall. Creek Bend Trail – Brad guessed we'd be finishing this project in 2028. On the I-35 Frontage Rd Trail, Brian asked if we'd eventually consider connecting the trail south to 33rd. He said we're kind of inviting cyclists to ride on 33rd and it's not safe. He asked if there were interim measures we might consider, and Brad said that was a good idea and he'd welcome EBC thoughts/ideas on that. On Kickingbird bike lanes, the City is just waiting on ODOT to complete its review. Brad said the 2nd St ADA project will take care of the crossing at Vista Lane/2nd St.
- 5. Update from the Trail-Naming Subcommittee.** John Harkess provided the latest information from the Subcommittee. The group just met at the MAC yesterday. The big takeaways were that we will refer to the Coffee Creek Neighborhood Trail without the word "Neighborhood." The group didn't like the name of the Crosstown Trail, but it also agreed that it shouldn't be shown on maps until improvements have been made, perhaps, to make the trail more concrete. The recommendations will be heard by the Parks Advisory Board on January 15 for approval.
- 6. Discussion of May Bike Month Activities.** The committee discussed some of the things we'd like to start planning for happening in May. Cycle 66 – Jennifer said it'll be in October. We asked if we could have a May 9 practice ride and Jennifer said she'd make it happen. Lissa wants to discuss a potential Bike to Work Day more thoroughly and it was agreed. Art Tours by Bike – Cinda was there earlier and she supports it. John said he would do another history tour. Jennifer said the finals

of the Oklahoma CC Mtb Series is May 30 on the Dam Trails at Arcadia Lake. Amanda said she'd have more swag bags.

7. **Discussion of Edmond Bicycle Committee Strategic Planning.** Vickie provided a handout which is a summary of all the work the EBC has been doing the last few meetings on strategic planning. She thinks it's a great basis for Edmond applying for League of American Bicyclists bicycle-friendly community status. She asked Kurt and Sean to help make application and they agreed.
8. **Upcoming Events and Announcements.** Amanda said there will be a bio-blitz at Arcadia Lake May 29-30 – volunteers help identify as much wildlife as possible.
