- 1. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 AM by Chair Vickie Williams in the Main Street Conference Room B at 22 E Main St Edmond, OK.**
- 2. Introduction of Members and Guests.** Chair Vickie Williams welcomed everyone. All present introduced themselves.
- 3. Approval of the Minutes of March 13, 2026, meeting.** Lissa noted a couple of corrections. John Harkess made the motion to approve the minutes. Lissa seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows:

- 4. Update from the OHSO Grant Subcommittee.** Sean gave an update on the progress made on planning the events for the OHSO grant. He said the subcommittee had a productive meeting on the previous Monday, April 6. He said the materials had been ordered, now we're just waiting for all of them to come in. The first event is UCO Earth Day on April 22nd.
- 5. Discussion of May Bike Month Activities.** The committee went through each activity and talked more about the details for each. Sean and Kurt gave an update on the plans for the Memorial High School Ride to School. Plans are to have 4 groups riding to school from different spots and arriving at about 8:30. Central Middle School – volunteers are needed to help table from 2:15 to 3:30. Michelle Magnusson is planning an activity. Lissa said the first casual ride of the year had 15 riders and it went great. Hugh said the Major Taylor group ride will be on May 2nd from 9-12 starting at Douglass High School. John stressed that people should show up for the proclamation of May Bike Month reading at City Hall on May 11. Catherine said the ribbon cutting on May 20 is only tentative. And Darrell said a hashtag everyone should use for May Bike Month is #BikeEdmond.
- 6. Discussion and Consideration of Amendment to the Ordinance Establishing the Edmond Bicycle Committee.** Vickie explained the amendment to add as an Ex-officio member a member of Edmond City Council to the EBC. The vote to approve the amendment was as follows:

7. **Presentation and Discussion of Engineering Project Updates – Brad Moery, Engineering Department.** Brad gave Engineering's quarterly update and started with the Arcadia Lake Trail - NW connector. He said there's a group meeting weekly to discuss. The contractor just had a concrete pour scheduled today. He mentioned some utility issues they've encountered. There was a question about whether signage would be needed at the intersection of the trail meeting with the Spring Creek Trail. Teresa asked about rumble strips. Good discussion of potential challenges there and possibly needing some signs. A completion date is expected to be around November. Questions also about the low-water crossing and cleaning up after storms. Kickingbird Bike Lanes – blacktop just put down. Environmental review still ongoing. Brad mentioned that ODOT could help get to 80/20 on funding potentially with end-of-fiscal-year funds. There's a walk-the-alignment taking place next week at Creek Bend Phase 2. Brad talked about the 2 bridges that will be required to complete the project. Darrell said this project has been discussed and been in progress/plans for 20 years, probably. The Spring Creek Trail connection along I-35 N to the YMCA and Library is going to be let between Aug-Oct. This is happening fast. The YMCA is scheduled to be open in November. Brad mentioned a new bridge on Post Road that will have pedestrian/bike infrastructure, which will certainly help with future plans for a sidepath along Post Road connecting the Route 66 Trail to the Arcadia Lake Trail. Not a lot of progress to report on Spring Creek to Carl Reheman due to the still-ongoing environmental review.
8. **Upcoming Events and Announcements.** Phil announced that ACOG has an active transportation survey posted and he's got posters to give out to help spread the word. Chase mentioned Al's Bicycles having a 40th Birthday Party on June 20th.
9. **Citizen Comments.** Taylor talked about the City's funding challenges and how CIP is trying to balance the varied interests. He said he thought it was good EBC is talking about how trails are being funded.
10. **Comments from the Edmond Bicycle Committee Chair and Members.** Chase noted that Mobility Commission didn't meet last month.
11. **Adjournment.** The meeting was adjourned at 9:39 AM. The motion was made by Lissa. Chase seconded the motion, and the vote was as follows.
