Purpose of Amendment:

The purpose of this amendment is to:

a) Extend the contract term one additional year, from an original expiration date of June 30, 2021 to a new expiration date of June 30, 2022.

b) To add the following cooperative clause;

Cooperative Use of Contract (aka Piggy-Back Clause). This agreement may be extended for use by other governmental agencies and political subdivisions of the State. Any such usage by other entities must be in accordance with the laws, ordinances, rules and regulations applicable to such entity, and the approval of the Contractor. The provision of goods or services to other agencies under this contract does not absolve the Contractor from fully complying with the requirements set forth within the contract for materials and services to be provided to the City under this contract. Any such action is subject to legal and contractual remedies available to the City including, but not limited to, cancellation or suspension of the contract.

In the event that another governmental agency chooses to use this agreement for procurement purposes, the procuring party shall be solely responsible for the ordering of materials, services or construction under this agreement. Payment, inspection and acceptance of goods or services ordered by the procuring party shall be the exclusive obligation of the procuring party. The City shall not be liable in any way for alleged or actual violations by the procuring party or Contractor, and the procuring party shall hold the City harmless from any liability which may arise from the action or inaction of the procuring party. Contractor agrees to look solely to the procuring party in pursuing all legal remedies that may be available to Contractor for acts or inaction of the procuring party. The procuring party shall not use this agreement as a method for obtaining additional concessions or reduced prices for similar products or services.

The following changes shall be made to the Contract Documents:

Add cooperative clause to contract and extend the term one additional year.
