I am pleased to inform you that, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 41-191.06 and § 41-191.08, the Attorney General's Office (AGO) has awarded the **El Mirage Police Department \$10,600.00** from the Victims' Rights Fund for the period, July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Revenues from the Criminal Justice Enhancement Fund (CJEF) remain strong. We are happy that your FY 2023 award will be similar to your FY 2022 award.

As you are aware, the purpose of the Victims' Rights Program (VRP) is to provide financial support to city, county and state entities that are affected by Arizona Revised Statutes Title 13, Chapter 40, *Crime Victims' Rights* and A.R.S.
