RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a request and acceptance of grant funds, if awarded, from the Tohono O’odham Nation 2023 revenue sharing program, an amount of approximately \$150,000 for a single purpose K9, patrol vehicle, and accessories; and authorize the Finance Department to make the necessary budget adjustments.

PROPOSED MOTION:

I move to approve an application submittal and acceptance, if awarded, of the Tohono O’odham 2023 revenue sharing program and authorize the Finance Department to make the necessary budget adjustments as presented.

BACKGROUND:

The El Mirage Police Department operates two patrol K9s, and their priority is to support patrol officers/high-risk events. When time permits, the K9s are used for proactive/investigative drug searches. Current patrol K9s are not trained/certified on fentanyl odors (national standard), and fentanyl has been nationally recognized as a critical problem impacting the community. Funds from this grant request of \$150,000 to the Tohono O’odham Nation 12% gaming distribution would be used to obtain a single-purpose K9, patrol vehicle, and accessories to accommodate the K9 dedicated to narcotics work.
