MEMORANDUM

To: Honorable Members of the Erie County Legislature

Re: Amendment of Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. Professional Services Agreement for Bridge Replacement - Sharp Street (CR 181) over Spring Brook
Date: May 2, 2025

SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is seeking authorization for the County Executive to execute an amendment to the agreement with Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI) for design engineering services. This agreement is for the replacement of the Sharp Street Bridge (PIN 5763.79). The design agreement was originally authorized in COMM. 9E-8 on May 26, 2022. The amendment is for an agreed upon change in scope of the design of the bridge replacement project.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for this amendment are not to exceed \$61,450 and are available in Fund 420, Fund Center 123, Project B.18014 – 2018 Fed Aid Project Bridge NY Program.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

GPI performed additional design work due to considerations of additional design alternatives, including the development of a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) due to additional highway work. In addition, numerous revisions to the Design Report were needed based on NYSDOT comments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Erie County received an award in the 3rd Round of BridgeNY for the replacement of this structure. This structure is rapidly deteriorating, is posted for load, and has barriers restricting access to the shoulders due to safety concerns. Replacement of the bridge is necessary.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

This action is required to ensure project advancement and financing through the BridgeNY Program for the design costs of the project. Negative action would halt design and result in continued deterioration of the bridge and the R-posting remaining in place, as well as jeopardize existing and future reimbursement funding available through the BridgeNY program.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will execute an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with GPI. Upon full execution, payment for services provided will be made.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, authorization is being requested for the County Executive to execute an amendment for additional design engineering services to the Professional Services Agreement involving the replacement of the Sharp Street Bridge (PIN 5763.79) (the "Agreement"), authorized by COMM. 9E-8 on May 26, 2022 with Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the amendment shall not exceed \$61,450; and

WHEREAS, the funds are available in Fund 420, Funds Center 123, through Capital Project - B.18014 -2018 Fed Aid Project Bridge NY Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive or Deputy County Executive to execute an amendment to the existing Agreement with GPI in an amount not to exceed \$61,450; and be it further

RESOLVED, that sufficient funding of \$61,450 is available in B.18014 -2018 Fed Aid Project Bridge NY Program, Fund 420, Fund Center 123; and be it further

RESOLVED, that authorization is hereby given for the Division of Budget and Management to make any technical adjustments necessary to effectuate this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature be instructed to forward two (2) certified copies of this resolution to the Department of Public Works, Commissioner's Office, and one copy each to the County Executive's Office, Comptroller's office, and Division of Budget and Management.
