Summary of Recommended Action

The attached resolution awards RFP #2025-038VF to Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd. It further authorizes the County Executive and Sheriff to enter into an agreement with Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd to conduct a feasibility study for implementing a 10 or 12 hour shift for Jail Management Division staff at a cost not to exceed \$53,600.00. The Erie County Sheriff's Office intends to use Telephone Revenue to fund this contract. Thus, this resolution authorizes the transfer of \$53,600.00 from the telephone revenue account into the Erie County Sheriff's Office, Jail Management Division general fund (Fund 110, Funds Center 116) Jail Phone Revenue (GL# 415622) and an accompanying increase of Professional Services Contracts and Fees (GL# 516020) by the same amount.

Fiscal Implications of the Proposal

As noted above, the contract with Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd. will be funded by jail telephone revenues.

Reasons for Recommendation

The Erie County Sheriff's Office is committed to providing quality public safety services in an efficient manner. Pursuant to that mission, RFP #2025-038VF was issued with the intent of determining how a 10 or 12 hour shift for sworn Jail Management Division personnel would impact overall personnel costs, specifically overtime. The RFP was released on July 23, 2025, with a due date for responses of August 20, 2025. Three responses were submitted. The cost proposal submitted by Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd. came in at the lowest price. A summary of the scoring for this RFP is below:
