#### SUMMARY

The resolution requests authorization to enter phase two with Hexagon to install, configure, and replace Computer Aided Dispatch and the Records Management System

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Central Police Services currently has a total of \$3,800,000 in existing funds for phase two implementation, configuration, and replacement of Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS) for Central Police Services.

### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The CAD and RMS systems, which are maintained by Central Police Services, are outdated and unable to keep up with modern technological advances.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Central Police Services maintains a comprehensive law enforcement records management system, "CHARMS" that is utilized by all local Erie County law enforcement agencies.

# **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

Failure to approve this request would restrict the ability of the CAD/RMS system to handle future emergency communications in Erie County, thereby not providing the citizens of Erie County with the most up-to-date emergency communication system.

# STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Central Police Services will work with Hexagon and the local PSAP's to implement the new CAD and RMS systems throughout Erie County. Certified copies of the resolution shall be sent to the County Executive's Office, Bureau of Purchase, Division of Budget & Management, Comptroller's Office and Central Police Services, attention: Antonio Morreale.

WHEREAS, Erie County Central Police Service has the responsibility of maintaining the countywide Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS); and

WHEREAS, Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS) are critical parts of the overall public safety operation of Erie County; and

WHEREAS, Central Police Services issued RFP 2023-002VF for Software Replacement for Public Safety Services, and Hexagon was selected to replace the existing home-grown CAD/RMS (Charms) system; and

WHEREAS, Central Police Services requests authorization to enter phase two with Hexagon to replace the CAD and RMS system including Professional services; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds received in Capital Projects Fund, A.25011 for \$3,800,000 (Replacement of Computer Aided Dispatch and Record Management Systems) and the Central Police Services/E-911 budget to provide the initial launch of phase two.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive or Deputy County Executive to enter into the phase two contract with Hexagon for the proprietary installation, configuration, and maintenance of the CAD/RMS system replacement in the amount of \$3,800,000; and it be further

RESOLVED, that sufficient funds to cover the cost of this implementation already exist in Central Police Services' Capital Project A.25011, Fund 410, Fund Center 16500; and be it further resolved
