Summary of Recommended Action

This resolution authorizes Erie County and the Erie County Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee to accept \$17,078.00 from the Police Traffic Services (PTS) Grant Program. This funding will be utilized by the Erie County Sheriff's Office for overtime details related to enforcement of seat belt and dangerous driving laws.

Fiscal Implications of Proposal

This resolution has no impact on county tax dollars.

Reasons for Recommendation

The goal of the Police Traffic Services (PTS) Grant Program is to increase seat belt usage and reduce dangerous driving behaviors. The Erie County Sheriff's Office shares the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee's (GTSC) goals. The Erie County Legislature must authorize the agreement to accept these funds, which are administered through the GTSC.
