SUMMARY

ECDOH's Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) is seeking authorization to contract with LaSalle Ambulance, Inc. d.b.a. American Medical Response (AMR) to implement a nurse navigation program in conjunction with its 911 emergency medical services system. The nurse navigator program will divert lower acuity calls to non-emergency room medical care facilities.

The areas where AMR will provide nurse navigation are:

City of Buffalo, Town of Cheektowaga, Town of West Seneca, Town of Aurora, Village of East Aurora, City of Lackawanna, Town of Hamburg, Village of Hamburg, Village of Blasdell, Town of Evans, Village of Angola, Town of Marilla, Town of Elma, South Wales Fire District #1

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

None.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The intention of AMR's nurse navigator program is to relieve local emergency rooms of unnecessary visits, prompting lower acuity calls to other medical care options and facilities and lower ambulance wait times. AMR is implementing the program at no cost also saving municipalities funds and resources on not having to implement their own programs.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

Emergency rooms will continue to experience unnecessary traffic from lower acuity calls and ambulance wait times will not improve.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

ECDOH will work with the County Attorney's Office on executing this resolution.

RESOLVED, the Erie County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive or Deputy County Executive to enter into contracts with LaSalle Ambulance, Inc. d.b.a. American Medical Response; and be it further
