

**A RESOLUTION SUBMITTED BY:  
LEGISLATORS MILLS, GREENE, TODARO, LORIGO**

**RE: Monthly Fiscal Status Reports**

**WHEREAS**, throughout the 2026 budget process, the County Executive, Comptroller, Deputy Comptroller, and Budget Director all warned the Legislature that the county will face a fiscal crisis in 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2026 budget did not take meaningful action to address any of the concerns expressed by any of the aforementioned officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the Comptroller's Office and Budget Office have very different roles and perspectives on the county's finances, and at a time when both offices are warning of fiscal problems, it is imperative that we establish a monthly Fiscal Status Report Meeting at the Legislature.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that this Honorable Body establishes a monthly Fiscal Status Report meeting to be held in the Legislature's Finance and Management Committee and directs the County Comptroller, Deputy Comptroller, Budget Director, and Deputy Budget Director to attend, upon receiving notice of the meeting from the Clerk of the Legislature, to provide their perspective on the county's fiscal health; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this resolution be directed to the Finance & Management Committee where it is so ordered that the item will exist as a placeholder for this discussion throughout the year; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Comptroller's Office shall come prepared to update the Legislature on the status of revenue collections throughout the county and the Budget Office shall come prepared to discuss the monthly budget monitoring report; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be sent to the County Executive, County Comptroller, Director of Budget and Management, and any other party deemed necessary and proper.
