

**A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED BY
LEGISLATORS TODARO AND MILLS**

Re: Reappropriation of Public Benefit Funds

WHEREAS, \$19,642.77 of Community Development funding appropriated as part of the 2025 Erie County Budget exists in General Ledger Account 227110; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$3,405.50 of funding appropriated via COMM. 8E-1 (2022) remains in General Ledger Account 227110; and

WHEREAS, this funding was designated by this Honorable Body for the Niagara Region Disc Golf Association with the intent of improving disc golf courses located within Erie County Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry would like to utilize these funds to carry out improvements to Erie County's disc golf courses in preparation for the Professional Disc Golf Association Amateur Disc Golf World Championships which will be taking place August 2026 in Western New York; and

WHEREAS, this event will create an economic development benefit to the many businesses in our region as well as bring notoriety to the world class disc golf courses located within Erie County's Heritage Parks, specifically Como Lake Park and Emery Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that authorization is hereby given to transfer \$23,048.27 of funds, located in Fund 610, Fund Center 16410, General Ledger Account 227110, Parks Donation Fund Trust, to the Niagara Region Disc Golf Association for the purposes of improvements to disc golf courses within Erie County Parks; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive and Deputy County Executive to enter into contract with Niagara Region Disc Golf Association for the purposes of transferring the funds; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Director of the Division of Budget Management and the Erie County Comptroller are authorized to take any action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be sent to the Erie County Executive, the Erie County Comptroller, the Director of Budget and Management, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry, and any other party deemed necessary and proper.
