RE: LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION – SERIES 12- FOR “Historic Brewing Company Barrel and Bottle House”

On December 17th, 2018 I initiated an investigation into an application for a series 12 (restaurant) liquor license filed by John Kennelly (Controlling Person and Agent) and Sherill Kennelly (Controlling Person). Historic Brewing Company Barrel and Bottle House is located at 110 S San Francisco St. John and Sherill are currently selling liquor at this location with their Series 7 license (#07030071) which is a beer and wine bar license, and John advised they are looking to stack this Series 12 license so they can sell liquors at their coffee bar inside the restaurant.

I conducted a query through local systems and public access on John and Sherill, and no significant derogatory records were found on any of the applicants. John was charged and pled guilty in 2004 for Selling Liquor to a Minor in the area of Sedona. John has taken the mandatory liquor law training and has provided proof with the application. I conducted a search of the current and previous liquor licenses possessed by the Kennelly's, and they possess a Series 3 (#03033009) on Huntington Drive and the current Series 7 (#07030071) in Flagstaff. I could not locate any violations against either license in Flagstaff.

I made contact with John over the phone, and he confirmed he would attend the council meeting on January 15th, 2019. He advised me the business hours would be from 11am to 10 pm on Sunday-Thursday and 11 am to 12 am on Fridays and Saturdays.
