

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-15**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COCONINO JOINT LAND USE STUDY A COOPERATIVE LAND USE PLANNING EFFORT BETWEEN LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND MILITARY INSTALLATIONS;**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) seeks to ensure the lasting compatibility of military installations and their neighboring communities;

WHEREAS, a JLUS creates a policy framework and recommends strategies that support a healthy economy, environment, and community, while safeguarding the military's mission;

WHEREAS, the Coconino JLUS concerns the Army National Guard Camp Navajo (Camp Navajo), Naval Observatory Flagstaff Station (NOFS), and surrounding areas;

WHEREAS, the Department of Defense (DoD) Office of Economic Adjustment (OEA), with contributions from Coconino County and the City of Flagstaff, funded this study;

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff City Council and Coconino County Board of Supervisors served on the JLUS Policy Committee which unanimously recommended adoption of the Coconino JLUS.

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the Coconino Joint Land Use Study be hereby adopted, and the Mayor be authorized and directed to take any further actions required to effectuate adoption on behalf of the City.
