

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING A MODEL UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND APPLICATION AND AFFIDAVIT FOR UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE, AS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona Fifty-third Legislature has adopted a new law, Chapter 330, located at A.R.S. §§ 9-1401 through 9-1403, 9-1411 through 9-1421, 9-1431 through 9-1433; 9-1441 through 9-1445, 9-1451 through 9-1452, and 41-1092.01 ("New Law");

WHEREAS, the New Law creates a new licensing system for businesses seeking to use and occupy local right-of-way for delivering video service, including but not limited to cable television and internet services;

WHEREAS, the New Law, specifically, A.R.S. § 9-1411(B) requires the cities to adopt a standard form of uniform video service license agreement and a standard form of application and affidavit as described by law on or before July 1, 2019;

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. In General.**

The standard forms attached hereto are hereby adopted by the City of Flagstaff. Nothing herein shall be construed to modify existing ordinances of the City.

**SECTION 2. Delegation of Authority.**

The City Engineer or his designee shall have authority to administer the New Law and may approve minor or clerical changes to the forms; however, any license issued pursuant to the New Law requires approval or ratification of the City Council.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.**

This resolution shall be effective from and after July 1, 2019.
