

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COCONINO COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR SHARED BUILDING INSPECTION AND PLAN REVIEW SERVICES.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff and Coconino County desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for shared building inspection and plan review services, on an as-needed basis, for development that occurs within corporate limits of the City of Flagstaff and in unincorporated areas of Coconino County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff and Coconino County find it necessary and vital that a Shared Service Agreement be implemented to be used during disasters or other extreme events that will task individual departments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff and Coconino County desire to participate jointly in activities that involve inspection and plan review services based on a need by either entity due to disaster, extreme workload experiences, lack of manpower experiences, or other; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has read and considered the staff summary report and proposed IGA attached thereto, and finds that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into the Agreement.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Coconino County and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A, which shall become effective upon the date first executed by both parties ("Effective Date").

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
