REF Liquor License Series 10 (Beer and Wine Store) Application for “Go Booze”

On August 16th, 2019, I initiated an investigation into an application for a new series 10 (Beer and Wine Store) liquor license for Go Booze located at 2001 E Huntington Dr, Suite 1. The application license number is 67335.

The new series 10 liquor license is being requested by Rafael Ilishayev (Controlling Person), Yakir Gola (Controlling Person), and Andrea Lewkowitz (Agent). I contacted Andrea over the phone, and she advised Rafael and Yakir live out of state and will not be overseeing the daily operations of this business as they have over a hundred of these locations nationwide. She advised me that they have appointed Jenna Brockman as the Premises Manager and have submitted her paperwork to the Arizona Department of Liquor Control. She advised Jenna will have completed her mandatory liquor law training.

I conducted a public access and local systems search of all of the parties in this application, and no derogatory records could be found of the applicants. Go Booze has four other locations in Arizona with Series 10 liquor licenses (2 in Phoenix, 1 in Tempe, and 1 in Tucson). I located two administrative violations against the Tempe store (#10076851) for not keeping record of a delivery and storing liquor on an unlicensed premise in April of 2019 and both violations were paid.

Andrea explained Go Booze will be a retail liquor delivery store where the store will deliver liquor to customers upon request for off-site consumption. Series 10 liquor licenses do allow for liquor deliveries for off-site consumption following a retail purchase. Andrea advised me she and Jenna Brockman would be present for the September 3rd, 2019 council meeting.
