

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-47**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF NORTHERN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY, AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE PROCESSING OF ORGANIC MATERIAL PRODUCED WITHIN CITY LIMITS AT THE UNIVERSITY'S PROCESSING FACILITY.**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, Northern Arizona University and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the purpose of creating a pilot composting program that will allow organic material produced within the City limits to be collected and delivered to the University's processing facility; and

WHEREAS, the City is exploring opportunities to process organic material produced within City limits with the intent of reducing the amount of material delivered to the landfill and reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and

WHEREAS, University has an existing composting operation that processes University's organic waste produced from its grounds operations and dining halls; and

WHEREAS, the parties intend to explore whether it is within each party's interest to expand the composting operation to accept material produced by the surrounding Flagstaff community.

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Board of Regents, for and on behalf of Northern Arizona University, and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A, which shall become effective upon the date first executed by both parties ("Effective Date").

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
