

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-55**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NORTHERN ARIZONA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AND CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR ARIZONA ROUTE 66 BROWNFIELDS COALITION GRANT; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the Northern Arizona Council of Governments (“NACOG”) and the City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for participation in the Arizona Route 66 Brownfields Coalition Grant funded by the federal Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for environmental site assessments for hazardous substances and/or petroleum of properties along the Route 66 corridor, to help reduce contamination and blighted conditions, and to revitalize land;

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. In General.

The Intergovernmental Agreement between the Northern Arizona Council of Governments and the City of Flagstaff for the Arizona Route 66 Brownfields Coalition Grant attached hereto is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Delegation of Authority.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the agreement, and to take all other necessary and appropriate actions to implement the agreement. The Contracts and Grants Manager and Community Investment Director are hereby delegated authority to work together to evaluate sites located within the City of Flagstaff eligible for grant funding and submit those to NACOG for funding consideration.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
