RE: Cinder Lakes Landfill Road

Dear Mr. Bertelsen, 

Thank you for your efforts and cooperation in the "Turnback" of Cinder Lakes Landfill Road to the City of Flagstaff. It is the County's understanding that the City of Flagstaff is working with the United States Forest Service (USFS) to realign and reconstruct the road to accommodate larger and heavier trucks. While the road is currently maintained by Coconino County, it is the County's understanding that upon completion of this project the City will take over perpetual maintenance of Cinder Lakes Landfill Road except snowplowing, which will be performed by the County as a courtesy to the City. In return for the snowplowing courtesy, the County would appreciate consideration in our current negotiations for County residents utilizing the HPC.

In support of this project, Coconino County has budgeted \$1.68M towards the reconstruction/turnback effort, with said funds to be disbursed to the City of Flagstaff equally between two fiscal years, \$840k in FY22 and \$840k in FY23. While the funding is currently budgeted for FY's 22-23, timing of the actual disbursements will be dictated by accomplishment of the project's major milestones as well as approval by the Board of Supervisors. The first disbursement will be made after the USFS has approved the project and issued all relevant permits and approvals to the City of Flagstaff for the uses, clearances, construction, perpetual maintenance, and all other activities necessary for the legal and safe operation of Cinder Lakes Landfill Road. The second disbursement will be made after the Turnback is formally approved by the Flagstaff City Council and County Board of Supervisors. Please keep us informed as to the status of this project so that we can budget the County's contributions accordingly.

Again, thank you for your efforts towards the upgrade and Turnback of Cinder Lakes Landfill Road. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to assist with this project and we look forward to continuing our partnership in serving the citizens of Flagstaff and Coconino County.
