**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE CITY
OF FLAGSTAFF POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE RECEIPT OF FUNDING
FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.**

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Phoenix Police Department, through the Arizona Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, is the recipient of the United States Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention grant regarding Internet Crimes Against Children; and

WHEREAS, the Phoenix Police Department has granted a sub award to the Flagstaff Police Department in the amount of \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously had an intergovernmental agreement governing the grant of funds for the past 15 years: and

WHEREAS, the parties are empowered by Arizona Revised Statutes § 11-952 to enter into this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has read and considered the staff summary report and proposed IGA attached thereto, and finds that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into the Agreement.
