# Historical Timeline



## 2019 Budget

- Council allocated \$100,000 in one-time general funds for households being displaced from the closure of mobile home parks

## 2018 & 2019

- Staff worked with Flagstaff Shelter Services and Coconino County Community Services' existing programs to assist Arrowhead Residents
  - Successful collaboration which assisted 35 households
- Staff was directed to create a relocation assistance program with the remaining \$84,526 in funding allocated for this purpose.



# Procurement & Program Creation



Request for Statement of Qualifications was established to identify housing service providers that had established programs in place to assist families and individuals in achieving housing permanency



Flagstaff Shelter Services was the single respondent



# Program Goal



To keep displaced populations housed and prevent them from entering Flagstaff's homeless system

- Utilize leveraged resources to maximize City investment.
- Provide housing case management services
- Access to Rapid Rehousing Funding or similar funding source with a housing permanency purpose
