Ballot Question Considerations

Possible Ballot Questions

- Affordable Housing
- Open Space & Parks and Recreation
- Charter Amendments **Not recommended for 2020**
- PSPRS Unfunded Liability
- FWPP Ongoing Funding
- CAAP Implementation
- Other Capital Needs
- Base Expenditure Limitation **Not recommended for 2020**



Other Considerations

Sales Tax Renewal

- Current sales tax expires in 2024
 - Prefer a 4 year window for renewal
 - November 2020

Franchise Election

- Unisource has requested a Special Franchise Election in August 2020.
 - Unisource pays for the cost of the election.



Committee vs. Commission

Committee

- Temporary
- Members appointed by City Manager
- More flexible in terms of meeting requirements

Commission

- Long-term
- Formalized in City Code (ordinance required)
- Members are appointed by City Council
- Subject to Open Meeting Law



Citizen Commissions/Committees

Options to Consider

- One single committee to evaluate all possible ballot questions
- One committee for each issue
- Combining some issues together for a smaller number of committees

- How long should the committee be active?
- What is the desired makeup of the committee?
