

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING OFFICIAL AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL/SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §16-642 requires that the City Council canvass the returns of an election no earlier than six (6) nor later than twenty (20) days following the election; and

WHEREAS, the General/Special Election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Flagstaff City Council.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said General Election for the City of Flagstaff, as shown by the Election Summary Report provided by the Coconino County Elections Department, Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof, was 43,230 out of 36,073 registered voters, for a 83.44% voter turnout.

SECTION 2. That the following results of the November 3, 2020, General Election are hereby declared official:
