City/NAU Composting Partnership



Pilot IGA approved by City Council in October 2019

- Pilot the collection and processing of City organic waste at NAU's composting operation
- Explore the collection and composting of organic waste streams in Flagstaff
- Pilot IGA has no financial considerations
- Option for a one-year renewal (through October 2021)





Summary of Impacts



- **To date, efforts have focused on organic waste from parks:**
 - Diverted over 200,000 pounds of grass clippings, pine needles, and leaves
- **Future efforts:**
 - Commercial food scrap pilot
 - Residential yard waste pilot
 - Dependent upon recession planning and grant opportunities





One-Year Renewal

Additional year will allow for:

- Pilot the processing of additional waste streams
- Evaluate costs
- Determine the framework for a long-term partnership
 - Develop an IGA with appropriate financial considerations and detailed roles and responsibilities
