

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, AMENDING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF NORTHERN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY, AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE PROCESSING OF ORGANIC MATERIAL PRODUCED WITHIN CITY LIMITS AT THE UNIVERSITY'S PROCESSING FACILITY.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Northern Arizona University and City of Flagstaff entered into an intergovernmental agreement on October 30, 2019 for the purpose of creating a pilot composting program that will allow organic material produced within the City limits to be collected and delivered to the University's processing facility ("NAU Composting IGA"); and

WHEREAS, the NAU Composting IGA allows for an amendment to enter into a one-year Renewal Term to continue to gather information regarding the composting program; and

WHEREAS, the parties intend to explore whether it is within each party's interest to expand the composting operation to accept material produced by the surrounding Flagstaff community.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby approves Amendment Number One to the NAU Composting IGA, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and authorizes the Mayor to take all necessary steps to execute the amendment.
