RE: LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION – SERIES 7 and 9-FOR “Flagstaff Liquor”

On August 25th, I initiated an investigation into an application for Series 7 (Beer and Wine Bar) and a Series 9 (Sampling) liquor license filed by John Phillips (Controlling Person) and Trevor Phillips (Controlling Person) The license # is 114824, and it is for Flagstaff liquor which is to be located at 1700 E. Route 66.

I conducted a query through local systems and public access on John and Trevor and I found no derogatory records. I found that John has an additional liquor license for a business in Prescott. I conducted a search for that business and discovered one violation for *No managers agreement form on file ARS 4-202.C* – which was cited on November 25th 2015. I discovered that Trevor has taken the mandatory liquor training course and I didn't find any evidence that Trevor solely has any other liquor licenses.

Trevor confirmed he would attend the council meeting on September 15^h, 2020. He advised the store hours would be typically be Sunday through Thursday 10am to 8 pm and they would be open until 9pm on Friday and Saturday. Trevor stated that his business model is to sell more higher end alcohol and does not desire to sell large 40oz beers. He advised that there would be some onsite consumption and his plan is to have food trucks come on the weekends to offer food for his patrons. This business is not built yet and is set to open in April of 2021. This site is not located within 300 feet of a school or church.
