RE: LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION – SERIES 12 FOR “Collins Irish Pub”

On August 26th, I initiated an investigation into an application for a Series 12 (Restaurant) liquor license filed by Jeffery Miller (agent), Ki Choi (Controlling Person) and Sean Speirs (Premise Manager). The license # is 11677, and it is for Collins Irish Pub which is to be located at 2 N. Leroux.

I conducted a query through local systems and public access on, Jeffery, Ki and Sean and I found no derogatory records. A current liquor violation check found none for Collins, however; a historical violation check found the following 8 violations: *Fail to report an act of violence ARS 4-244.37 (1/12/99)* *Fail to report an act of violence ARS 4-244.37 (10/16/2000)* *Furnish alcohol to an underaged person ARS 4-244.9* and *Failure to request ID from an underage buyer ARS 4-241.A (8/26/2002)*, *Underage on premises w/o parent ARS 4-244.22 (06/23/05)*, *Underage on premises w/o parent ARS 4-244.22 (06/06/2016)*, *Selling liquor to an intoxicated person ARS 4-244.14* and *Intoxicated person on premises for thirty minutes ARS 4-244.14 (12/29/2016)*. Sean provided evidence of taking the mandatory liquor training.

I spoke to Ki over the phone. He advised that he attend the council meeting on September 15^h, 2020. He did not know that exact hours he was going to open but thought he would be open to 11pm on weekdays and midnight on weekends as long as he has food orders for his kitchen. He advised that he plans on following the CDC guidelines and the Governors Orders to allow for 50% occupancy and social distancing. This site is not located within 300 feet of a school or church.
