

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-64**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE  
WATER CONSERVATION STRATEGIC PLAN**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff recognizes the critical importance of water conservation in long-term water resource planning; and

WHEREAS, projected water conservation savings allow the City of Flagstaff to confidently delay water resource infrastructure investments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff wishes to be a national leader in water conservation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff Water Conservation Program worked with Maddaus Water Management to model and assess water conserving actions across the Flagstaff community; and

WHEREAS input from the Water Commission, steering committees, and the general public was actively sought during the strategic planning process to select appropriate conservation actions from those modeled; and

WHEREAS the Flagstaff City Council approved the actions outlined in the Optimized Conservation Program on December 3, 2019 for inclusion in the final draft of the Water Conservation Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS the Optimized Conservation Program outlined in the Water Conservation Strategic Plan is projected to defer approximately \$160 million in new water supply costs and save an additional 690 acre-feet of water over existing water-conserving actions over the next 20 years.

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS  
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The City of Flagstaff hereby adopts the Water Conservation Strategic Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. That the Water Services Division makes use of the Water Conservation Strategic Plan in long-term water resource planning.

SECTION 3. That the Water Conservation Program implements the measures and recommendations in the Water Conservation Strategic Plan.
