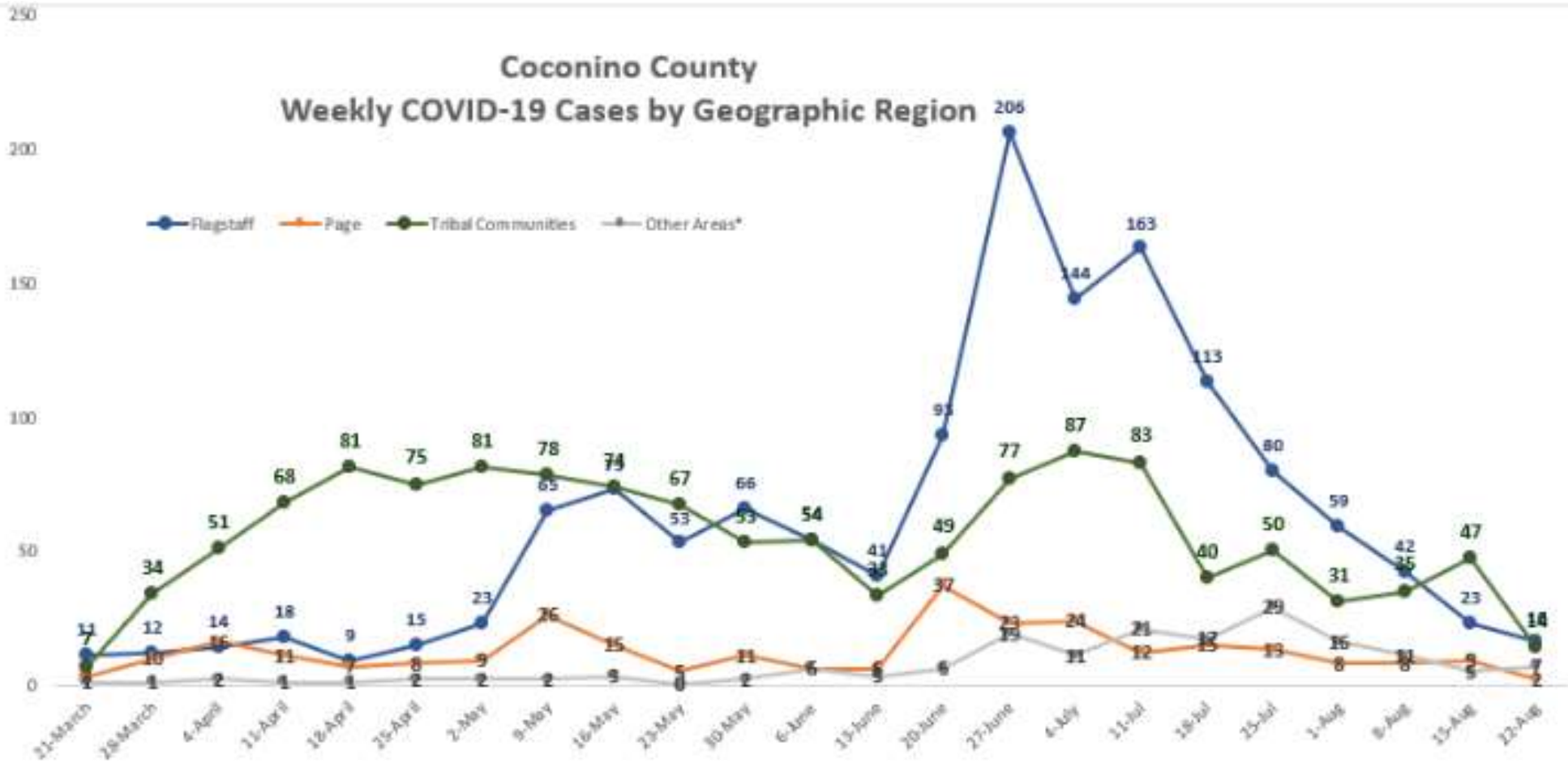




# CCHHS: COVID-19 Cases



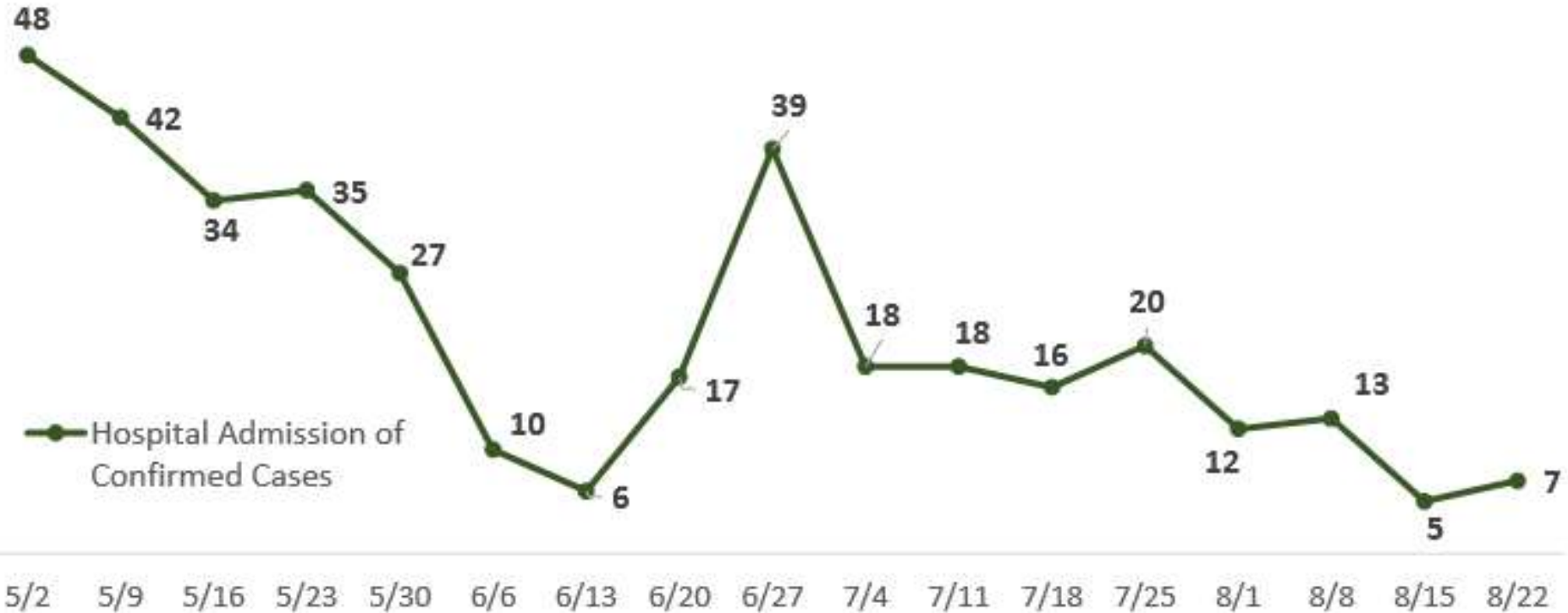
### Coconino County Weekly COVID-19 Cases by Geographic Region

# CCHHS: Community Transmission

## Community Transmission

- Coconino County has a current **incidence rate of 38 per 100,000**, **percent positivity of 3%**, and **COVID-19-Like-Illness incidence (CLI) of 4.0%\***.
- Coconino County is currently at a **moderate** level of community transmission.

Benchmarks	Minimal	Moderate	Substantial
Cases	<10 cases/100,000	10-100 cases/100,000	>100 cases/100,000
Percent Positivity	<5%	5-10%	≥10%
COVID-19-Like-Illness	<5%	5-10%	>10%

\*Incidence rate and percent positivity data are from week 34 (CLI data from week 33 due to reporting lag)



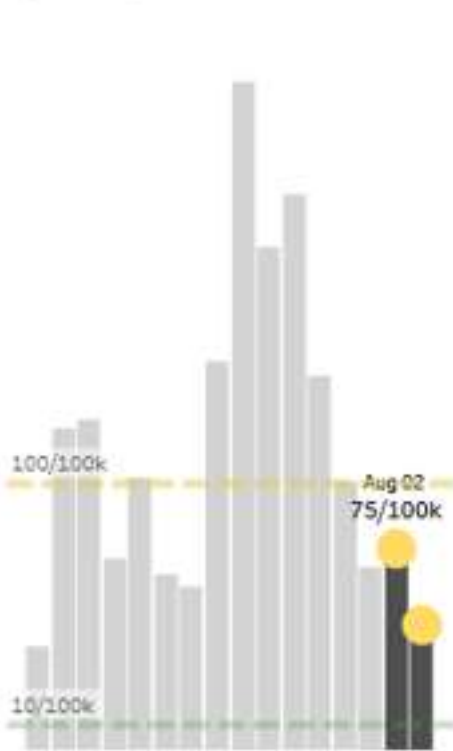

Business Reopening Status: **Moderate**

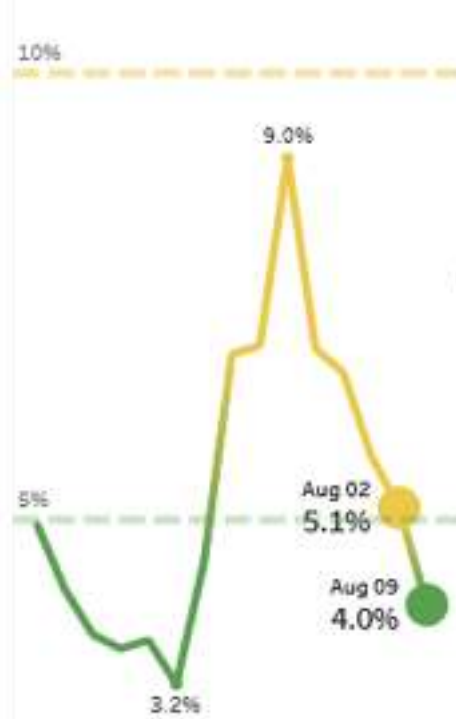
1) Cases per 100,000 individuals

# Phase 3 - Special Events on City Property



- Limited and/or modified to minimize gatherings to 50 people or less
- Gatherings of more than 50 people will be postponed
- Council discretion for events up to 250 people



# Temporary Use Permit Criteria



Level of Transmission	Event Information
Substantial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No events permitted.</li></ul>
Minimal to Moderate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Events with up to 50 people that provide for clear physical distancing.</li></ul>
None to Minimal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Events with up to 250 people provide COVID precautions as identified in CDC and AZDHS guidelines (see below). Ability to limit groups of 10 or more from congregating.</li></ul>
None/Vaccine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Return to pre-COVID conditions.</li></ul>



# Council Discretion

- Community transmission level of none to minimal for events up to 250 people

Benchmarks	Minimal	Moderate	Substantial
Cases	<10 cases/100,000	10-100 cases/100,000	>100 cases/100,000
Percent Positivity	<5%	5-10%	≥10%
COVID-19-Like-Illness	<5%	5-10%	>10%

- Bring special event permits larger than 50 to Council for discussion
