Site Specific Plans



- Implemented after City moves to Phase 3
- Covers Libraries and Recreation Programs & Facilities
- Multi-tiered approach
 - Numbers admitted
 - Hours of operations
 - Entrance requirements
 - Access to specific areas and/or programs
 - Cleaning and disinfecting
- Updates to plans will be posted on City's website

Masks





Proclamation



- Must wear a Face Covering when in Public Place except
 - when able to maintain adequate Social Distancing,
 - for medical conditions or disabilities,
 - for religious beliefs,
 - when eating or drinking,
 - when exempted under law, or
 - when not practicable or feasible



Current Employee Language



- Employees wear a mask when they are
 - in a public area,
 - outside of your office,
 - in a meeting with others,
 - in a vehicle with others, and
 - when in contact with the public



Current Employee Language

- Employees do not wear a mask
 - when working alone in their office,
 - are able to be six feet or further from one another,
 - working in a Fire station,
 - driving alone in a City vehicle, or
 - outside and adhering to social distancing guidelines.
- Employees who are unable to wear a mask, or whose essential job duties are impeded by the wearing of a mask, should speak to their supervisor and Human Resources about available accommodations.



Current Customer Language



- The public will be encouraged to wear masks when entering City facilities
- When an in-person meeting with a customer is required, customers may be required to wear a mask
- Encouraged to use hand sanitizer and wear a mask
