Project Overview

In November 2018, Mountain Line initiated the development phase of the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project to study potential long-term improvements and high-frequency bus service from the Flagstaff Medical Center to Woodlands Village. BRT is a toolbox of transit enhancements that add up to a **faster trip** and an **improved passenger experience**.

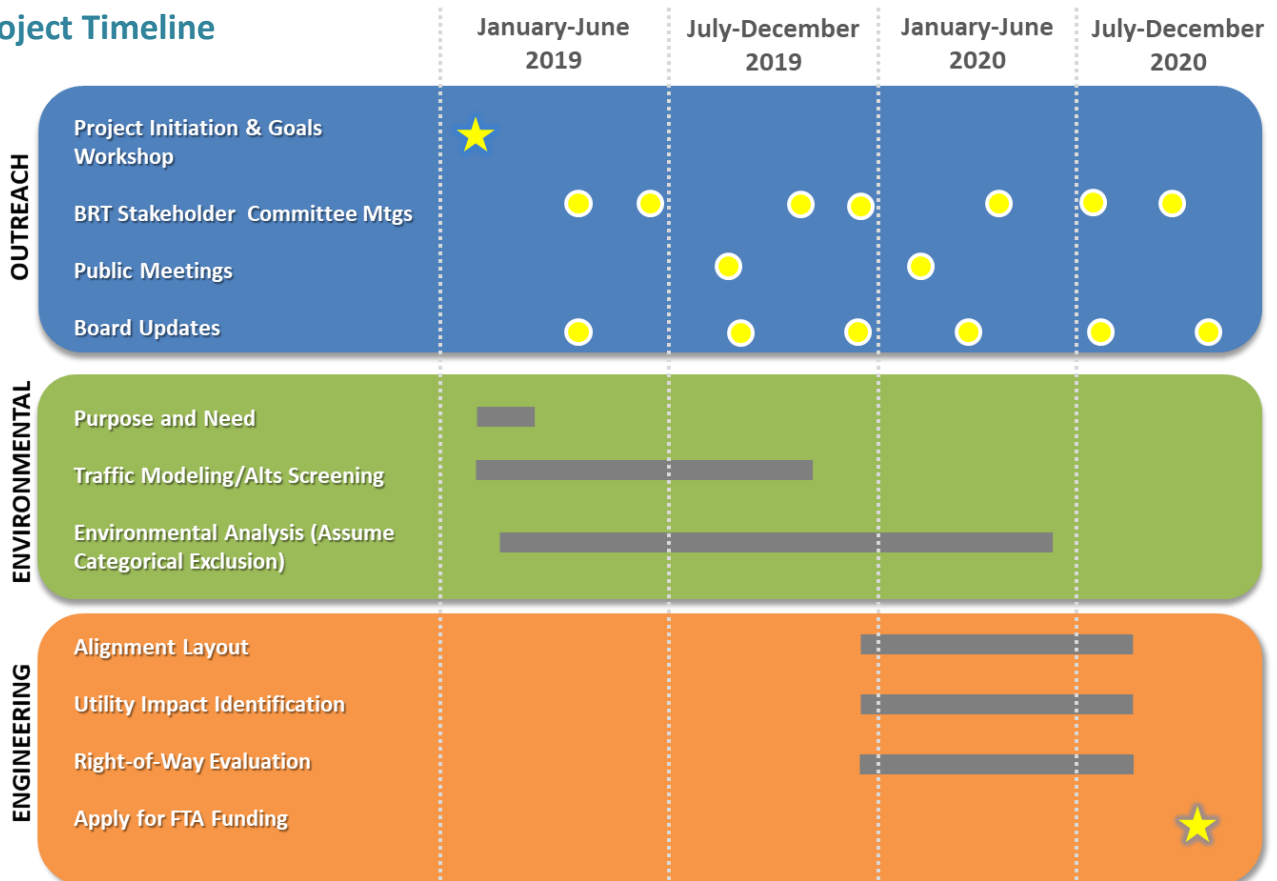
As a result of Mountain Link Route 10, our first BRT that opened in 2011, system-wide ridership increased 66% in the first year alone and, in subsequent years, spurred economic development along the Mountain Link corridor. Mountain Line anticipates similar results with a second BRT.

A team of agency stakeholders has been advising staff on technical aspects of the project. Over the past five meetings, stakeholders have provided critical feedback on the project's purpose and need, alignment alternatives, criteria to screen alternatives, and the results of the evaluation.

Project Goals

- ENHANCE** Make transit and multimodal mobility in Flagstaff more compelling
- CONNECT** Connect neighborhoods and activity centers and improve local mobility
- DEVELOP** Support economic development goals
- SUSTAIN** Create an environment that will sustain over the long term
- THRIVE** Strengthen the downtown core and connections to Woodlands Village, NAU, and the Flagstaff Medical Center

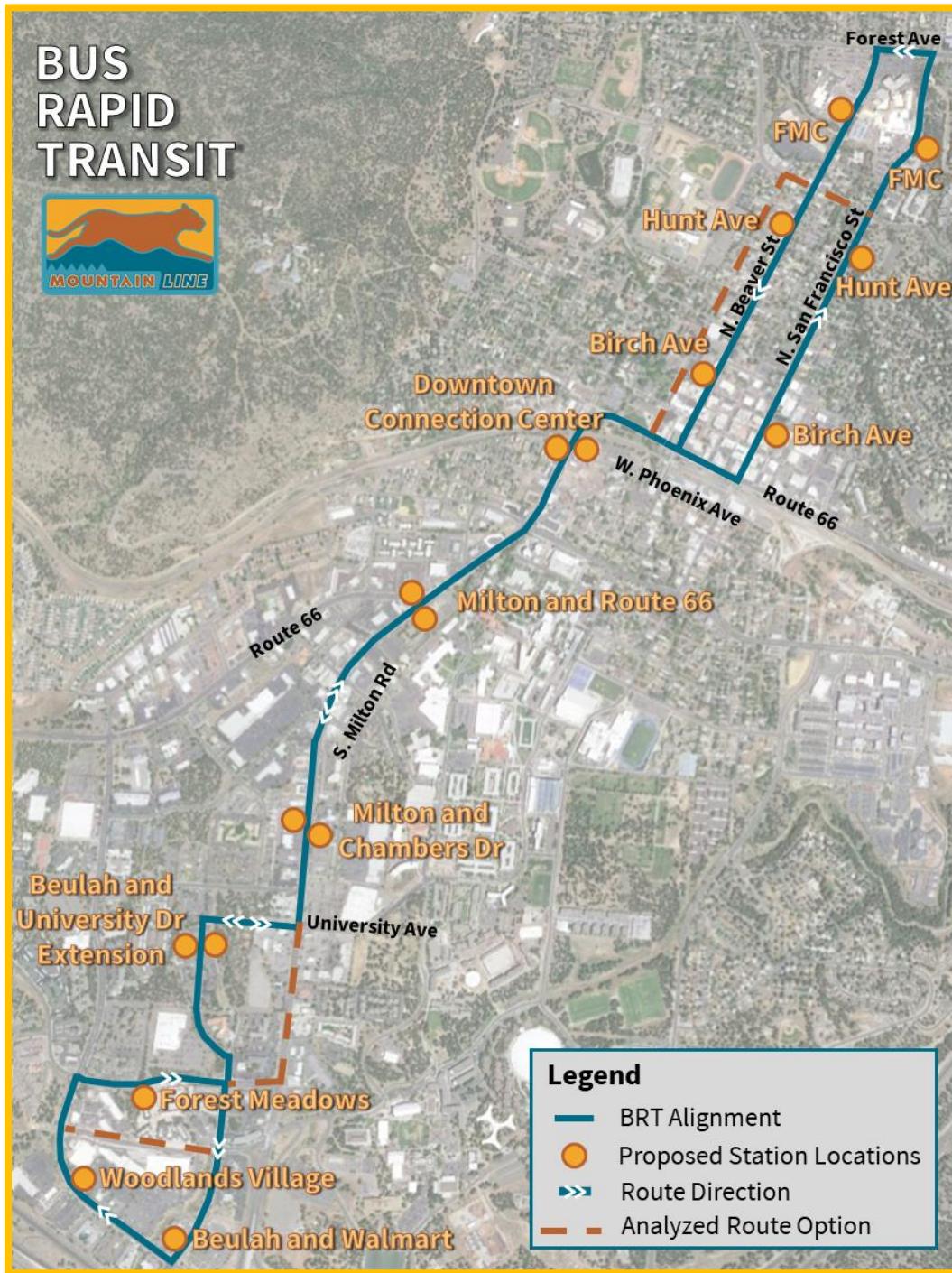
