

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-18**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE  
UPDATED FLAGSTAFF AUTOMOTIVE SALES TAX REBATE PROGRAM TO  
FURTHER THE CITY'S CLIMATE ACTION GOALS AND TO SUPPORT LOCAL  
AUTOMOTIVE DEALERS**

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has authority pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 9-500.11 to spend money on economic development activities; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide funding for an auto sales tax rebate program to further climate action goals and to support local automotive dealers by providing an incentive to locally purchase energy efficient vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the funding is derived from local transaction privilege tax revenues generated by the hospitality industry (also known as the "BBB tax") and dedicated for economic development activities; and

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2020 the City adopted Resolution No. 2020-43 establishing the Flagstaff Automotive Sales Tax Rebate Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Flagstaff Automotive Sales Tax Rebate Program.

**ENACTMENTS:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. In General**

The City Council hereby amends an updated Flagstaff Automotive Sales Tax Rebate Program, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A. This updated program will apply to any awards granted after the effective date of this resolution.

The Economic Vitality Division Director or the Director's designee is delegated authority to undertake all such actions necessary to implement the program, provide information about the program to the public, and to provide a report on and any recommendations related to the program prior to April 1 on an annual basis

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.**

This resolution shall be immediately effective.
