

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN NORTHERN ARIZONA INTERGOVERNMENTAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (HEREAFTER MOUNTAIN LINE) AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MOUNTAIN LINE KASPAR & LINDA VISTA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Mountain Line and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to define their respective roles and responsibilities in relation to the Kaspar & Linda Vista Improvements Project (the Project), which is located on and within City right of way near Mountain Line headquarters located at 3773 N Kaspar Drive, Flagstaff, AZ 86004, more specifically the Kaspar Drive and Linda Vista intersection; and

WHEREAS, on or about November 15, 2015, Mountain Line completed the Kaspar Drive/Route 66 Intersection Analysis to identify the preferred alternative for the Kaspar Drive/Route 66 intersection (the "Study"). The City as well as the Flagstaff Metropolitan Planning Organization ("FMPO") were active stakeholders in the Study; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to contribute to the cost of the Project and is willing to cover the cost of City inspection and testing, plan review, traffic impact analysis review, chip seal, and stormwater user fees on behalf of Mountain Line for this Project, currently estimated to be around \$250,000. ("User Fees").

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Mountain Line and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
