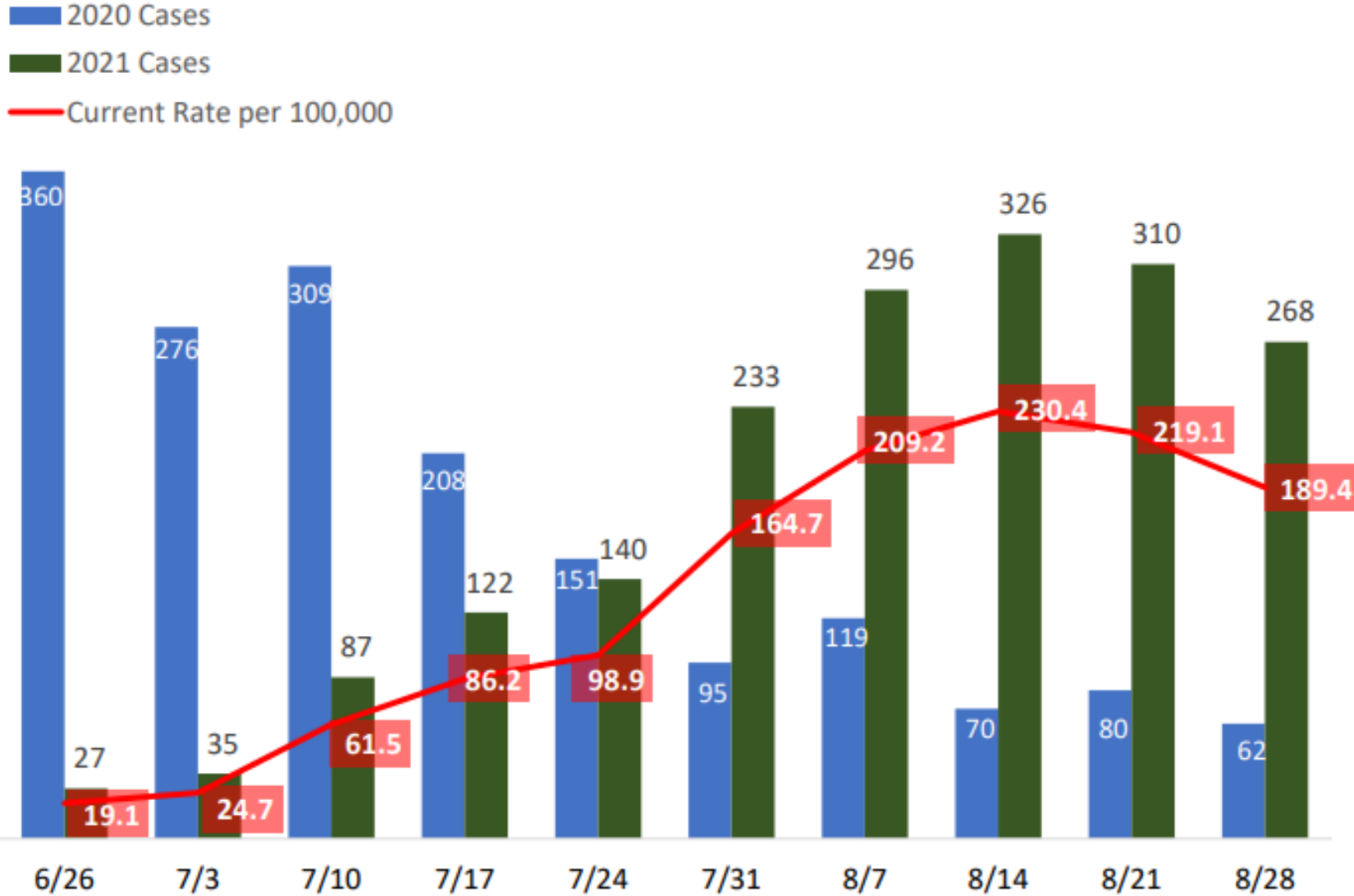

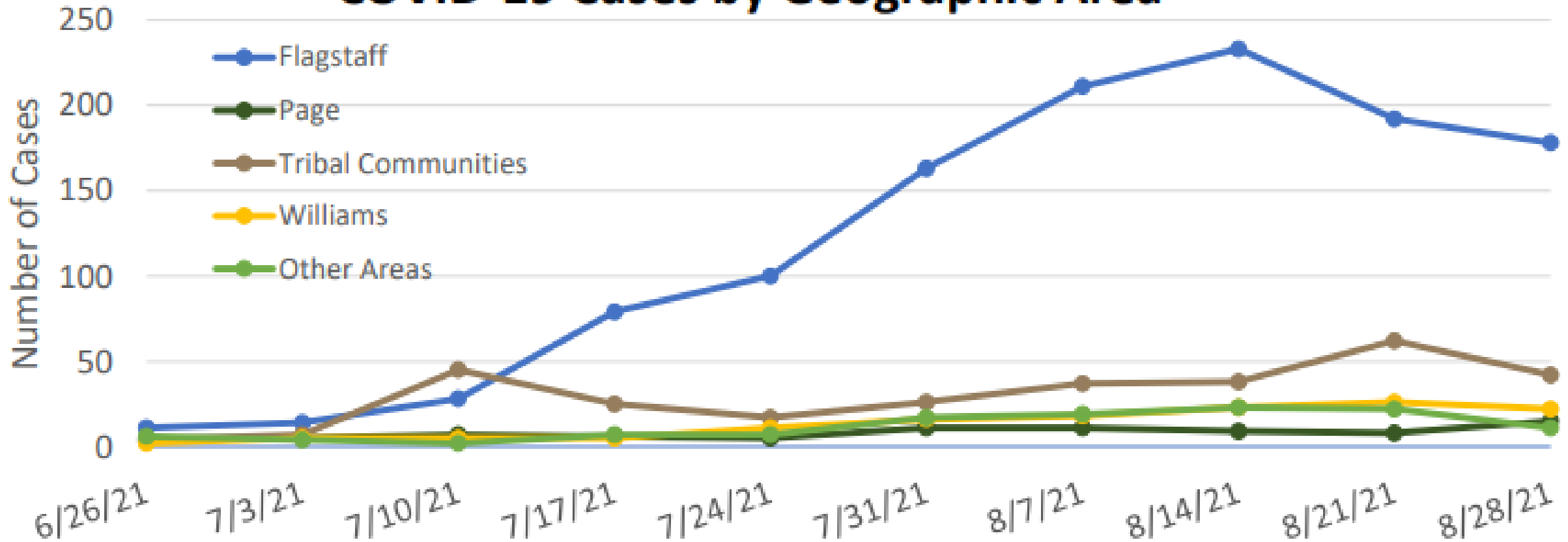

COVID-19 Cases by Geographic Area



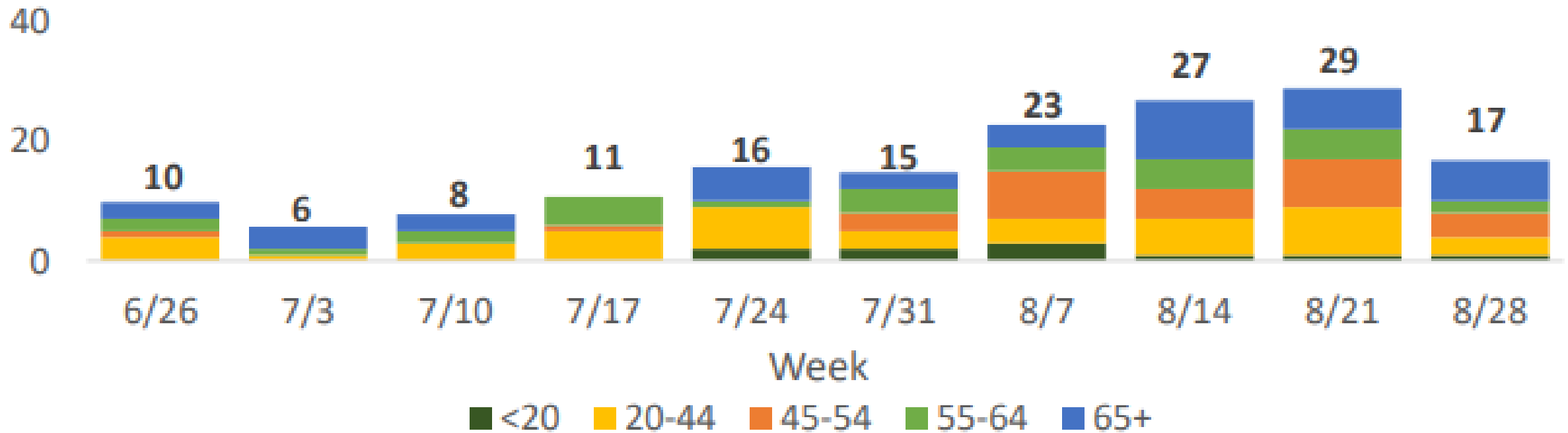

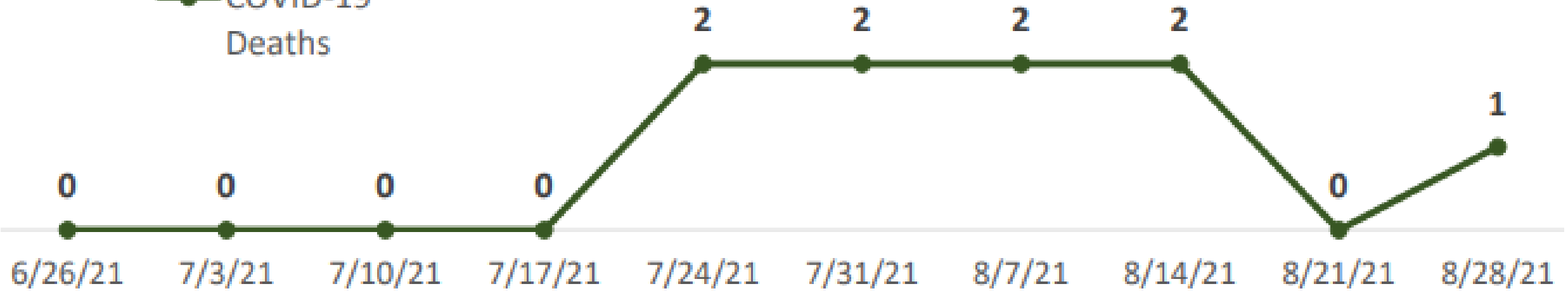


CCHHS: COVID-19 Related Deaths

CCHHS: Community Transmission



Community Transmission

- Coconino County has a current **incidence rate of 189.4 per 100,000**, **percent positivity of 5.8%**, and **COVID-19-Like-Illness incidence (CLI) of 5.0%***.
- Coconino County is currently at a **High**** level of community transmission.

Total number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered: **153,266**

Total number of COVID-19 vaccine doses ordered: **100,318**

Percent of COVID-19 vaccine doses utilized: **152.8%**

Total number of people who have received at least one dose of COVID-19: **84,141**

Percent of people vaccinated: **57.1%**

Number of people who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19: **72,795**

Coconino County Total Variants of Concern**



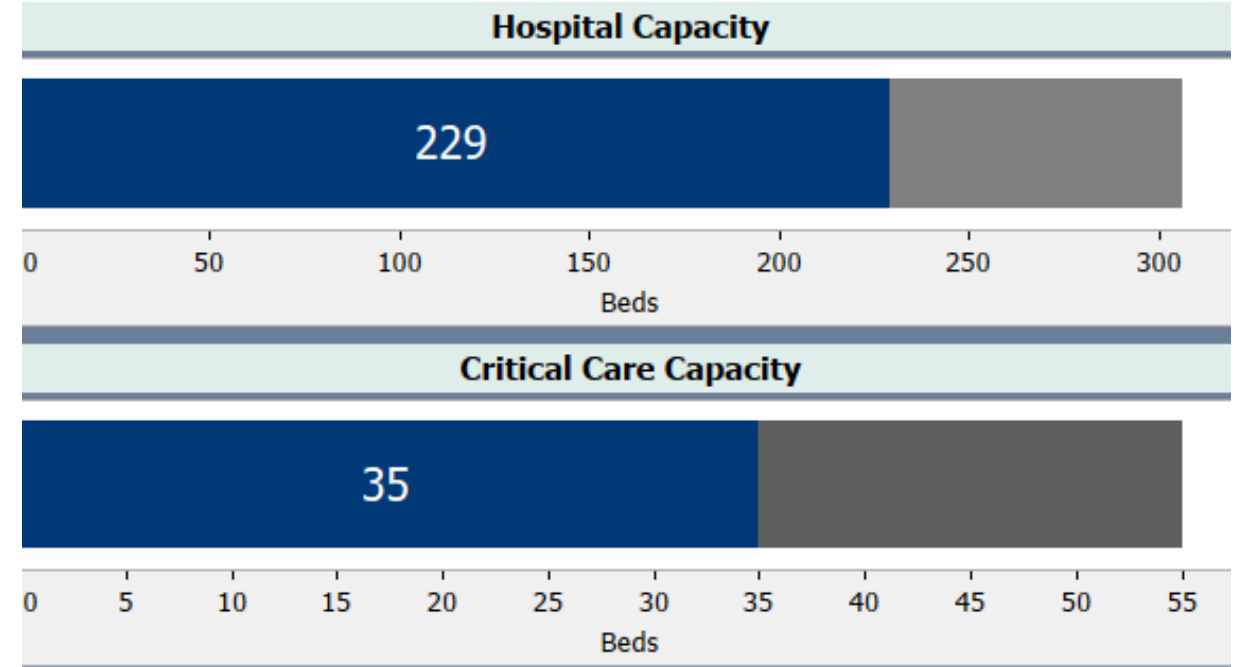

Current data suggest that COVID-19 vaccines authorized for use in the United States offer protection against variants currently spreading in Coconino County.**

- Navajo Nation

- Re-emphasis of Safer at Home Public Health Emergency Order
- Mandated masking in public
- Orange status
 - Businesses limits to 50% maximum capacity
 - Schools



Indigenous Nations Update

- Hopi Tribe

- Encouraging vaccines for everyone ages 12 or older
- Recommends face-masking inside public buildings, common areas and outside where physical distancing is not possible
