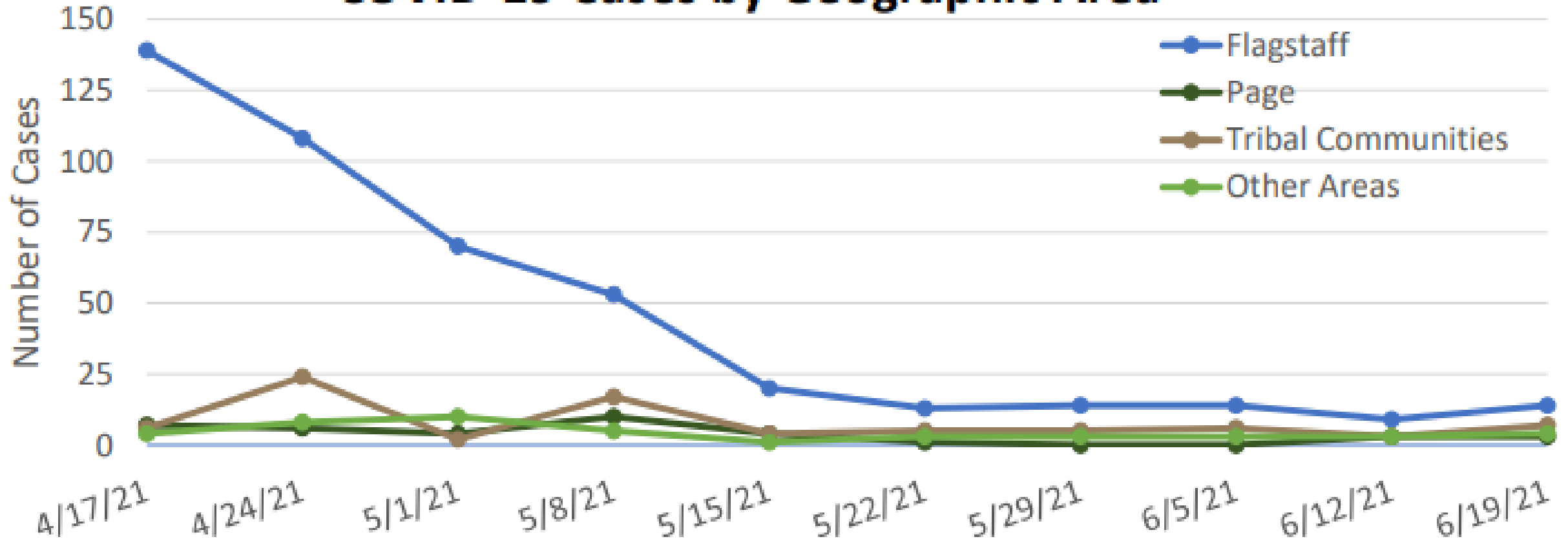

CCHHS: COVID-19 Weekly Cases



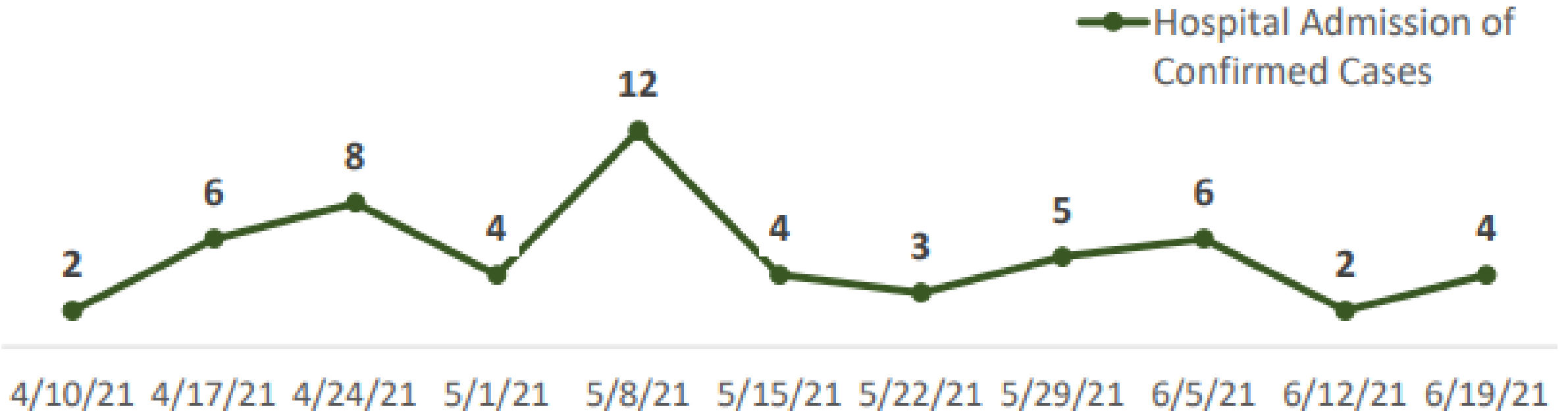
COVID-19 Cases by Geographic Area

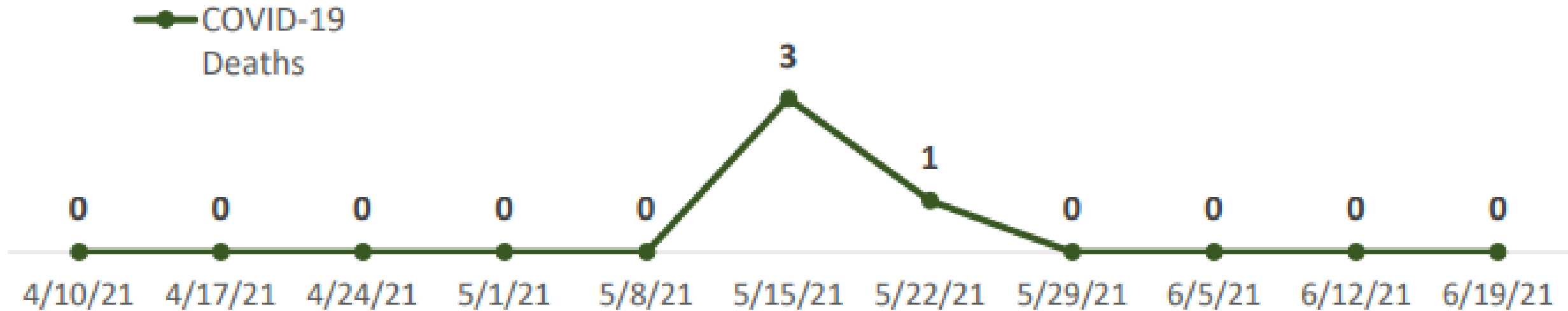
Weekly Case Counts Among Coconino County Residents:

CCHHS: Community Transmission

Community Transmission

- Coconino County has a current **incidence rate of 19.8 per 100,000**, **percent positivity of 3.0%***, and **COVID-19-Like-Illness incidence (CLI) of 1.6%****.
- Coconino County is currently at a **moderate***** level of community transmission.

Benchmarks	Minimal	Moderate	Substantial
Cases	<10 cases/100,000	10-100 cases/100,000	>100 cases/100,000
Percent Positivity	<5%	5-10%	>10%
COVID-19-Like-Illness	<5%	5-10%	>10%

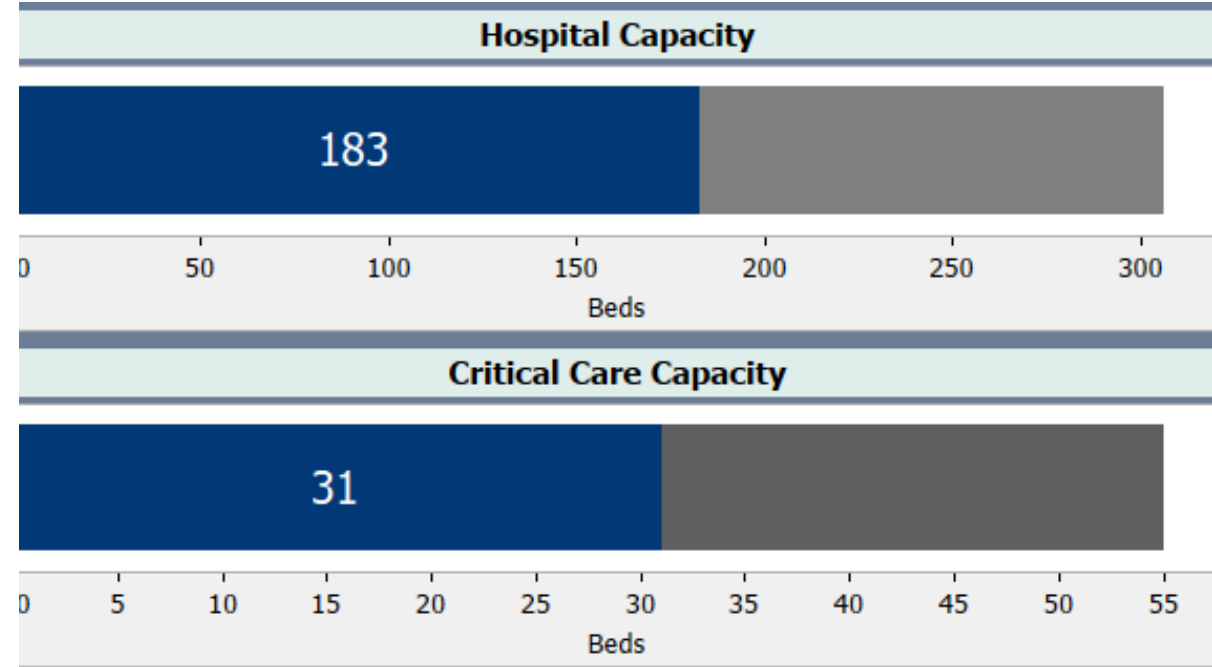
