

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MOUNTAIN LINE AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT OF THE FIRST MILE LAST MILE GRANT

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Mountain Line and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to describe roles and responsibilities for project management of the First Mile Last Mile grant; and

WHEREAS, the First Mile Last Mile grant represents \$5,536,075 in federal funding awarded to Mountain Line through Sections 5307-5339, a Federal Transit Administration grant program administered by the Arizona Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff and Mountain Line intend to use the grant funds to construct a variety of pedestrian and bicycle projects that will help complete walking and biking networks and improve access to transit; and

WHEREAS, pedestrian and bicycle projects funded with the First Mile Last Mile grant will be cooperatively managed by the City of Flagstaff and Mountain Line; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has read and considered the staff summary report and proposed IGA attached thereto, and finds that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into the IGA.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Mountain Line and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
