

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PHOENIX POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE RECEIPT OF FUNDING FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Phoenix Police Department, through the Arizona Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, is the recipient of the United States Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention grant regarding Internet Crimes Against Children; and

WHEREAS, the Phoenix Police Department has granted a sub award to the Flagstaff Police Department in the amount of \$3,500; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously had an intergovernmental agreement governing the grant of funds for the past 17 years; and

WHEREAS, the parties are empowered by Arizona Revised Statutes § 11-952 to enter into this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has read and considered the staff summary report and proposed IGA attached thereto and finds that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into the agreement.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Phoenix Police Department and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
