UWNA Application Process

- **Grant Announcement**
 - City of Flagstaff will announce the grant
- **Volunteer Evaluation Recruitment**
 - Local volunteers are recruited from among flagstaff community members, UWNA Board members and City employees.
- **Evaluation process**
 - Review applications
 - Conduct site visits (as needed)
 - Score application utilizing a rubric
 - Program design
 - Target population/Demographics
 - Budget
- **Funding Decision Process**
 - Rubric score used for initial funding recommendation
 - Volunteer round table for final funding recommendations
 - Proposed funding recommendations presented to City of Flagstaff
 - Award letters and contracts delivered to organization
