

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE PARTIAL SETTLEMENT OF THE CASE, CITY OF PHOENIX ET AL. V ORBITZ WORLDWIDE ET AL, RELATING TO COLLECTION OF LOCAL TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE TAXES FROM ONLINE TRAVEL COMPANIES; PROVIDING FOR DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interests of the City to enter into a third partial settlement of the pending litigation, City of Phoenix et al. v Orbitz Worldwide et al.; and

WHEREAS, state law provides for the confidentiality of taxpayer information.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The City Council hereby authorizes the third partial settlement of the pending litigation, City of Phoenix et al. v Orbitz Worldwide et al, on remand in Arizona Tax Court, Case No. TX2014-000470 as discussed in Executive Session.

SECTION 2. Delegation of Authority.

The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized and directed to execute such documents and take such other actions as are necessary to carry out the purpose of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall be immediately effective.
