URGENT UPDATE – University Avenue Barriers – September 2, 2022

The Transportation Commission met Wednesday afternoon, June 1, 2022, to discuss the traffic calming barriers on University Avenue. Since the previous update, City Staff modified the earlier barriers near University and Tombaugh and installed a temporary traffic circle at University and Majestic. City Staff presented new traffic data they felt showed reduced speeds east of Majestic and recommended the Traffic Commission approve all three strategies.

About a dozen owners spoke during the meeting to express their opposition to the current options and as Committee Chairman, I received nearly a dozen e-mails opposing the approach, which I summarized. Generally, owners felt there was only a minimal impact on slowing speeds where they are highest, introduced some risk to cyclists and pedestrians, and created hassles navigating the circles – all with little benefit. The Commission engaged in further discussion and finally directed City Staff to move forward and contact vendors to discuss final design and construction services to make these barriers permanent later in 2023.

I would like to be sure every owner has the opportunity to support or oppose this decision. Please click on this **SURVEY** to share your opinions. Although the project is moving forward, one Member, **Commissioner Kate Morley made comments I strongly support**. She said, in part, "I think it is disappointing to hear that the community still doesn't like the designs in front of them. Later she says, "My alternative to that is that we do something very drastic here, because nothing seems to be satisfying. My gut is that traffic volumes are only going to increase." And shortly thereafter, she summarizes, "we either work through a final design on what is in front of us, or work with the Community to do something way more drastic knowing that traffic volumes are only likely to increase." Please note that Commissioner Morley's full comments and the entire discussion were recorded and can be accessed on the City of Flagstaff website.

As Committee Chair, I want to hear from everyone and will summarize those opinions. Please take this **SURVEY**. But as an individual owner, I oppose these current strategies, in part because they have minimal effect and introduce safety concerns. But my biggest concern is that City Staff will consider their work finished, without addressing speeding and volume issues in other areas, especially several places on Highland Mesa. There are more traffic issues than just University Avenue that need resolution and **I agree with Commissioner Morley and feel we need to consider a drastic alternative**. Transportation Commission Comments - October 5, 2022

“Good afternoon Madam Chair and Commissioners. My name is Brian Lee Wilson and I live in Boulder Pointe. In your June Meeting, you heard numerous owners express concerns about the trial barriers on University Avenue. Commissioner Morley expressed her disappointment that residents remained unhappy and wondered whether a new approach was needed. Her idea was supported in the Chat Box, but was **not** acknowledged during the meeting, nor were additional public comments permitted.

We had good participation at the meeting, even with less than 2 business days’ notice, but I wanted more feedback and sent out a survey. As a courtesy, I sent a copy of the survey and background material to Staff a couple weeks ago. I e-mailed 465 owners and received 305 surveys in return – that’s a significant response rate of almost exactly 2/3. Just looking at those who expressed an opinion, I want to share a few findings:

- The Neighborhood **OPPOSES** the Traffic Circle at University & Majestic by a ratio of more than 4 to 1.
- Owners overwhelmingly **DO NOT**, by almost 10 to 1, **DO NOT BELIEVE**, that the barriers on University will solve the traffic issues, and
- More than **6 times as many** residents **SUPPORT** versus **OPPOSE** Commissioner Morley’s comments about an alternative approach that addresses concerns now and in the future.

Before I finish, I want to make a comment on process. The last traffic study was completed May 2nd. I waited over 2 weeks for Staff to analyze the data and **then** requested information on May 19 - still 2 weeks **before** the June Meeting. But I didn’t receive any files until 1 hour before the meeting, leaving **zero** time for analysis. I don’t think it’s fair to deny me data I could have used to support **my opinions** on this barrier’s effectiveness.

The Development Agreement stipulates that the City develop a **system** of traffic calming features that are acceptable to the neighborhood. You now have feedback from over 300 owners showing they broadly disapprove of your current choices. I’m asking the Commission to direct Staff to **continue** working with Boulder Pointe residents to develop an **expanded** approach that includes features as referenced by Commissioner Morley. Thank you for your time.”
