

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF NORTHERN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY, AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE PROCESSING OF ORGANIC MATERIAL PRODUCED WITHIN CITY LIMITS AT THE UNIVERSITY'S PROCESSING FACILITY.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Northern Arizona University and City of Flagstaff entered into an intergovernmental agreement on October 30, 2019, for the purpose of creating a pilot composting program that will allow organic material produced within the City limits to be collected and delivered to the University's processing facility ("NAU Composting IGA");

WHEREAS, on October 30th, 2020, the NAU Composting IGA was renewed for an additional one-year term to continue to refine processes and gather data on the composting program;

WHEREAS, the parties intend to expand the composting operation to accept material produced by the surrounding Flagstaff community; and

WHEREAS, the new NAU Composting IGA is for a five-year term to establish a long-term composting program.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby approves the NAU Composting Intergovernmental Agreement, attached here as Exhibit A, and authorizes the Mayor to take all necessary steps to execute the Agreement.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
