Intergovernmental Agreement with State of Arizona

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR LOCAL TAX ADMINISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR EXPIRATION OF THE EXISTING AGREEMENT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has adopted local transaction privilege taxes, use taxes, and/or other excise taxes pursuant to the Model City Tax Code, as set forth in the Flagstaff City Code, Division 3-05 Privilege and Excise Taxes;

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona (Arizona Department of Revenue) and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for local tax administration;

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Arizona and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto ("New IGA"), which shall become effective upon the date first executed by both parties ("Effective Date").

SECTION 2. Expiration of Existing Agreement.

The existing Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Arizona and the City of Flagstaff dated June 16, 2015, Contract #2015-131, as modified by the Modification effective July 1, 2016, shall expire as of the Effective Date of the New IGA.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
