

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GLENDALE AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR THE USE OF THE GLENDALE TAX APPLICATION

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, The City of Glendale and the City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for use of the Glendale Tax Application (TAX APP); and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona collects Transaction Privilege Taxes (TPT), often referred to as Sales Taxes, for all Cities, Towns and Counties of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Arizona for the collections of TPT; and

WHEREAS, the City desires manage data from TPT data from businesses located in the City of Flagstaff in an effective manner; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale has built a program to help manage TPT data that is very efficient and effective for managing TPT accounts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale is offering the City of Flagstaff access to the TAX APP program to improve our effectiveness of management local TPT accounts.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Glendale, Arizona and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
