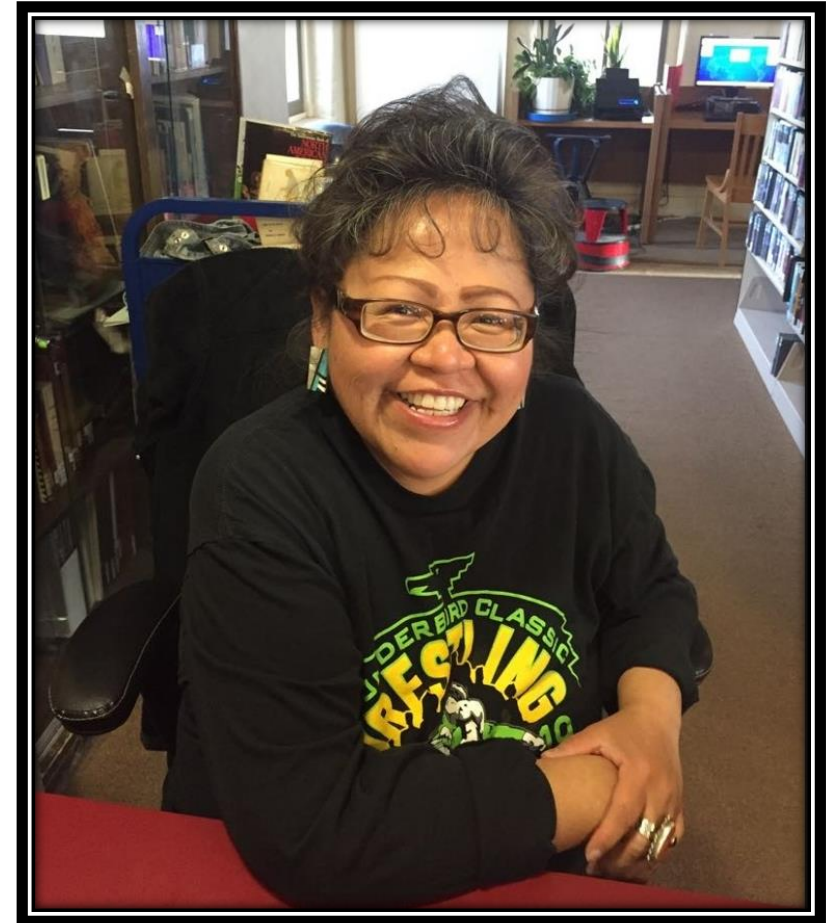
Trish's supervisor, Pearl Goldtooth, shared with us.
