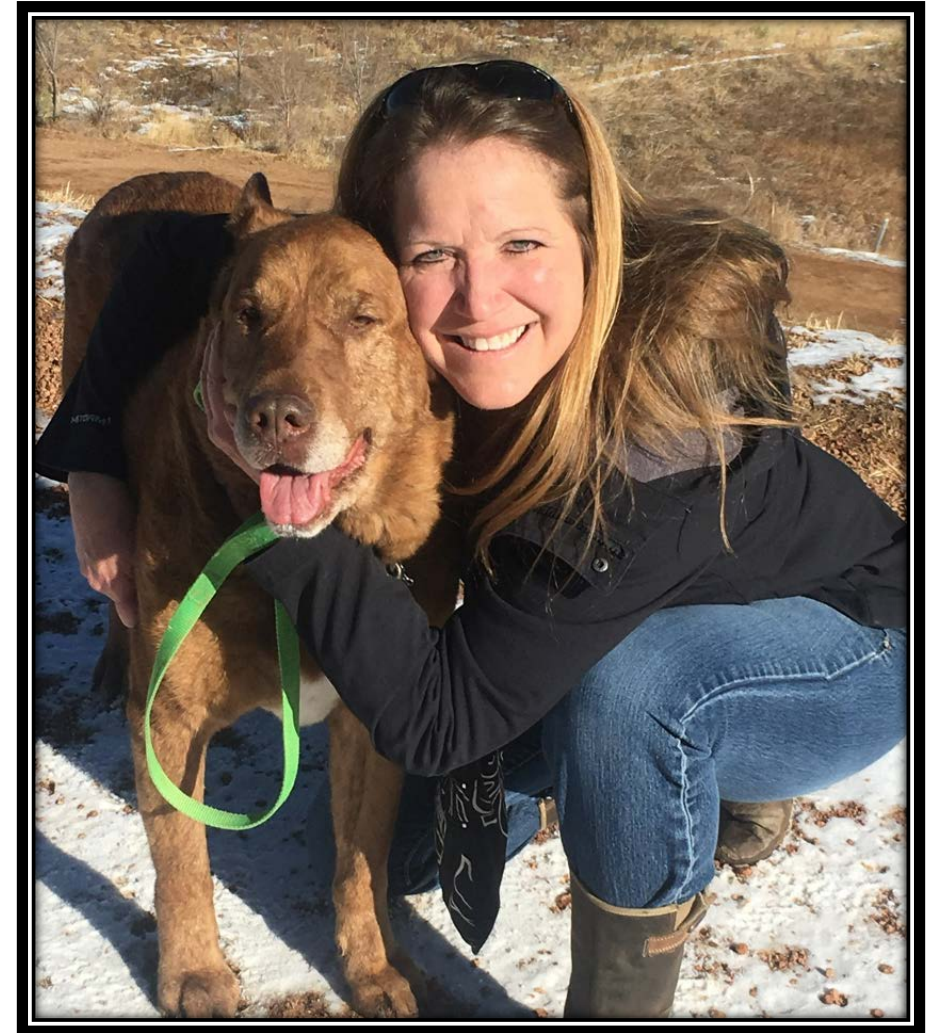


25 Years Plus!!!
