

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, ADOPTING THE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, walking and biking are important to Flagstaff, and the Flagstaff community is supportive of active modes of transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff Regional Plan 2030 includes goals to “increase the availability and use of pedestrian infrastructure, including FUTS, as a critical element of a safe and livable community” and “provide for bicycling as a safe and efficient means of transportation and recreation;” and

WHEREAS, a number of other City of Flagstaff plans and documents, including the Carbon Neutrality Plan, the 10-Year Housing Plan, and the Regional Transportation Plan, recognize the importance of walking and biking as means of transportation; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2018, the voters of Flagstaff approved Proposition 419, which extends the City’s transportation sales tax and will provide an estimated \$29 million over the next 20 years for pedestrian and bicycle facilities; and

WHEREAS, active transportation supports other City objectives and values, including carbon neutrality and sustainability, equity and inclusivity, economic vitality, public health and safety, housing attainability, open space and recreation, community and neighborhood character, and quality of life.

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City of Flagstaff hereby adopts the Active Transportation Master Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and City Council hereby commit to implementation of the polices and strategies detailed in the Active Transportation Master Plan to achieve its stated goals.
