Subject: Flagstaff Regional Plan Update Scoping

The Flagstaff Regional Plan is a policy guide, serving as the general plan for the City of Flagstaff and an amendment to the Coconino County Comprehensive Plan. The plan covers a range of topics with information on current conditions, our vision for the future carefully developed goals and policies to realize the future vision. The Flagstaff Regional Plan will be developed over four years, corresponding to four different phases of public participation and development (see slides for graphic).

At the upcoming Indigenous Commission meeting, the project team will engage the Commission in learning about the Regional Plan, the process for updating it, and discussing how to engage in assessing the content of the current Regional Plan. The topics of equity and inclusion are not well represented in the current plan, which is a deficiency the update process seeks to address. Staff encourages members of the Commission to familiarize themselves with the Regional Plan by reviewing it at www.flagstaff.az.gov/regionalplan. We will follow up on this initial step in the next few months with opportunities to provide individual feedback and discussion within the Commission.
