

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-59

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLAGSTAFF CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COCONINO COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF FOR LICENSE TO USE CITY PROPERTY AT CINDER LAKES LANDFILL

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Coconino County Flood Control District and City of Flagstaff desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for License to use city property at Cinder Lakes Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the District is undertaking flood control projects in residential areas that require on-site fabrication of pipes; and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of the fabrication process, a location away from residential properties is required; and

WHEREAS, the District's contractor will require a 190' x 100' area for the pipe fabrication equipment, which will be placed on two concrete slabs (the "Pipe Fabrication Facility"); and

WHEREAS, the District's contractor will also require an additional 1000' x 500' area for a pipe storage/laydown yard for the finished products (the "Yard"), which will include the area for the Pipe Fabrication Facility; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District have agreed that a location at the City's Cinder Lake Landfill has the ability to accommodate the Yard/Pipe Fabrication Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In General.

The Flagstaff City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between Coconino County Flood Control District and the City of Flagstaff, Arizona, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.

This resolution shall be immediately effective upon adoption.
