NIMS Designation

What is NIMS?

- Original concept created in the 70's
- Post-2001 attacks, DHS led a national effort to consolidate, expand, and enhance previous versions
- Comprehensive, national approach to incident management
- Applicable to entire spectrum of potential incidents, hazards, and impacts, regardless of size, location or complexity



NIMS Designation

Why do we need it?

- Provide a common standard for overall incident management
- Defines operational systems
- NIMS links the Nations responders together
- Federal requirement
- Governor of Arizona issued Executive Order 2005-08 designating NIMS for all incident management in Arizona



NIMS Designation



Resolution 2023-62

- Establish the NIMS as the City of Flagstaff standard for incident management and emergency planning
- Designate City Emergency Management as the Local Point of Contact to coordinate NIMS activities and ensure compliance
